Geocentrix Ltd creates and sells software for geotechnical engineering design; provides training in the application of that software; provides training in the interpretation and use of engineering design standards; and provides consulting services in geotechnical design. Geocentrix Ltd operates in the civil engineering sector and has customers worldwide but mainly in the UK.

Turnover

Geocentrix Ltd's turnover is less than £36M and hence the company is not required to produce a slavery and human trafficking statement for each financial year.

Our policy

As a micro-business, it is not practical for us to perform due diligence on all companies in our supply chain. We ensure that there is no modern slavery or human trafficking in any part of our business or, as far as we are able to check, in our supply chain. Our Anti-Slavery Policy reflects our commitment to acting ethically and with integrity in all our business relationships.
